Treasurer - Gina Asuncion Bernier

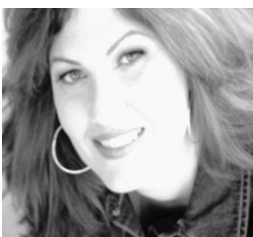
